



SOQPA SOCIAL DISTANCING PROCEDURES

PERSONNEL:

- **When you arrive at the fairgrounds, please leave at least 15 feet between trailers**
- **Face masks are encouraged but not required. No contestant will be penalized for wearing a face mask while showing their equine.**
- **We ask that only immediate family or required help attend the show with the exhibitor. Please no extra spectators.**
- **Keep 6 feet between you and other families/households when possible.**
- **Anyone with compromised immune systems, anyone that is sick or showing any symptoms, please do not attend our show.**
- **Please show from your trailer unless stalling overnight.**
- **Keep all show equipment at your trailer (not at the arena) to minimize gathering.**
- **For the safety of everyone, we will NOT be providing any concessions. Be prepared to bring your own food and drinks.**
- **Participants not complying with Social Distancing Procedures will be reminded of the procedures and may be asked to leave if they do not comply. (Entries will be forfeited)**

ENTRIES:

- **We encourage you to pre-enter for classes, stalls and camping. You may enter and pay the day of the show but you must bring your own pen.**
- **If registering or paying in person, only ONE person representing the exhibitor should come to the entry booth.**
- **Stall and camping reservations may be called in or texted to (740)474-8000. Reservations must be received by noon on Wednesday prior to the show.**
- **Fillable pdf entry forms can be found at SOQPA.com or our Facebook group "SPQPA Files". Download and complete the forms and return to s.o.quarterpony@gmail.com**
- **We are offering 2 payment options; Pay using VENMO to Sally-Walters-7 or pay at the show with cash or check.**
- **If using Venmo, payment must also be received by Wednesday prior to the show.**
- **Pre-entries will still need to check in at the entry booth to pick up back numbers and confirm you are actually at the show. If you already have your back number, you can check in by email at s.o.quarterpony@gmail.com. (The email header should include the date of the show and your back number)**
- **There will be an additional \$2 fee per horse for 2020 to help defray the additional costs, due to COVID-19, of keeping the fairgrounds clean and safe for everyone.**



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STALLING & CAMPING:

- **To reserve stalls, call or text (740)474-8000 by the Friday before the show. Stalls will be pre-assigned. If you do not receive a text of your stall numbers, you will need to check in at the entry booth BEFORE putting your horse in a stall.**
- **One empty stall MUST be left between groups and/or individual to allow for social distancing.**
- **Please groom and prepare your horse IN your assigned stall, NOT in the aisle way.**
- **One-Way traffic patterns will be posted in the barns. Enter and Exit signs will be posted.**

IN AND AROUND THE ARENA:

- **Hand sanitizer and disinfectant stations will be set up at contact points around the arena, entry booth, stall barn and other high traffic areas.**
- **Bleachers will be closed/taped off for the safety of everyone.**
- **We ask that you only be near the arena when you or your immediate group member is showing and keep 6 feet from other exhibitors and groups.**
- **All spectators MUST stay back 6 feet from the arena fence. (if you are not working the gate or in the class showing, STAY OFF THE FENCE please.**
- **Only horses in the next class will be allowed in the warm-up area while classes are being judged. (Pee-Wee exhibitors will be allowed 1 other person with them)**
- **Horses will enter the ring when the prior class lines up to minimize passing of exhibitors at the gate.**
- **Please only meet up with your group once you have exited the warm-up area.**
- **Tack changes will be excused from the line-up so that you may return to your stall or trailer to change.**
- **Judges will stay more than 6 feet away from contestants. (patterns will reflect this)**
- **Your ribbons and paybacks will all be available, at one time, when you are finished showing for the day. Please be patient with us and do not come to the entry booth after each of your classes for ribbons.**
